#### Overview

Create a presentation that describes YOU.

Probably want to use PowerPoint, but format is up to you (must turn something into D2L).

Duration should be about 3 minutes (plus 1 minute to setup and assume no questions).

Easiest option is: post everything online on personal website, test it and turn in copy of pptx/mp4/games before class, else you will need to plugin laptop and setup that way

Things to consider showing:

- What are you good at?
- What experience do you have?
- What have you done in the past? (show examples)
- Why would someone want you on their team (or hire you)?
- What do you want to accomplish this semester?
- How should someone remember you?
- Anything else that reflects well on you and about you.

# For the Artistically Skilled:

You may want to include a caricature of yourself to demonstrate your art style, skill, habits...

## Grading

Grades will be based on how well you present yourself. Content of the presentation will be taken into consideration. However, grades will not be based on the quality of past work, but on how you use and organize such to present yourself. This is expected to be a *professional presentation*, so the context is one where this presentation would be acceptable to give to co-workers, or as part of an interview process. Clothing can be informal but should be considered carefully. It too should reflect what you want people to remember about you.
